THE MEOW

Cats have many different meows with different meanings. Mainly used to control humans.



THE HISS

Stay away I'm not happy right now.



THE SIREN

Also known as caterwauling. Your un-neutered cat is desperate to get out & meet other Tom cats.



THE SCREAM

A scream of pain by female cats most likely to occur during sex.

THE HIGH UP

A sign of confidence and contentment. Also tells other cats they're willing to be friends.



THE SWISH

Your cat is focused on an object or something moving outside



THE WAG

Stay away from the wag. This cat is feeling threatened and is ready to pounce.



THE CURVE

A curved tail indicates a more playful mood. Grab a toy and get playing.



THE PURR

This is one happy cat. Keep doing what you're doing!



EYE-BALLING

Cats give each other the eye when they want them to stay away.



THE BLINK

A slow blink is a sign of respect & submission. She's happy & content.



RUBBING

Rubbing against your legs is a sign of affection. They are also marketing their territory with their scent. Charming!



TUMMY-TIME

Another sign of submission. Cats also do this when feeling threatened so be warned!

EAR LANGUAGE

There are a tonne of different meanings behind each ear movement. *Familiarise yourself* with what each one means.



THE HIDDEN

Indicates feelings of shame, sorrow, submission or fear.
